
Build your business with the Seminole Nation Capital Fund

How does the program work?

The program provides credit support to lenders to help them make your loan. As a borrower, you work directly with your lender and the small business technical service providers.

Is the program right for me?

Any business in Seminole County with less than 750 employees may be eligible, as well as any business owned by a Seminole Nation Members and Citizens anywhere in the U.S.

How can it help my business?

You can use the program to get a business loan for working capital, construction, real estate or equipment.

How do I participate?

Contact your local bank, and follow their loan application process. If they need help approving your loan, they can contact the program for support.
